- A member of a law enforcement explorer program seeking to enroll in eligible courses to prepare for a career in criminal justice

*Up to four (4) recipients will be chosen from the eligible applications to be awarded a \$1,000 scholarship.*

**Application Deadline: January 31, 2018**

**Requirements include the following:**

- Completion of the scholarship application
- Copy of your latest high school or college transcript
- Resume including educational history, work history, and school/community activities
- Essay: *What do you foresee being the greatest challenge in your field of study? Provide insight into how you will address those challenges (500 – 1,000 words).*

**For selected recipients:** *Upon proof of enrollment, the scholarship funds will be paid directly to the educational institution for the awarded semester. If the recipient is unable to maintain the criteria above, the award or any unused balance thereof shall be returned to the SCAA.*
